The advent of digital photography has sparked a 'new' interest in photography and the need for effective instruction in the use of digital imagery.

We are privileged to have Rotarian Malcolm Brownlee PHF (Paul Harris Fellow) as the instructor. He is a professional photographer who provides his time free of charge, and so also do all other volunteers, mentors and assistants. This is the 3rd year venture with 14 successful courses completed.

The course consists of five, two-hour weekly workshops (including an evening field trip). Mentors are appointed to assist small groups. It is conducted at the Victoria Police Academy in Glen Waverley, where Malcolm has his studio. Currently, the courses are on Tuesday nights between 7 and 9pm.

The next course will commence on the 14 November 2006 (places filling fast) and 5 courses are set for 2007 commencing on the 23rd Jan, 13th March, (1st May- a 'Retouching Course') 19th June, 7th August, 25th Sept, and 13th November- a 'Retouching Course'.
